# Regions

## ► VINHOS VERDES

## ► DÃO

The area has a mediterranean climate with hot summers and cold winters, which allows for a variety of grape varieties to thrive.

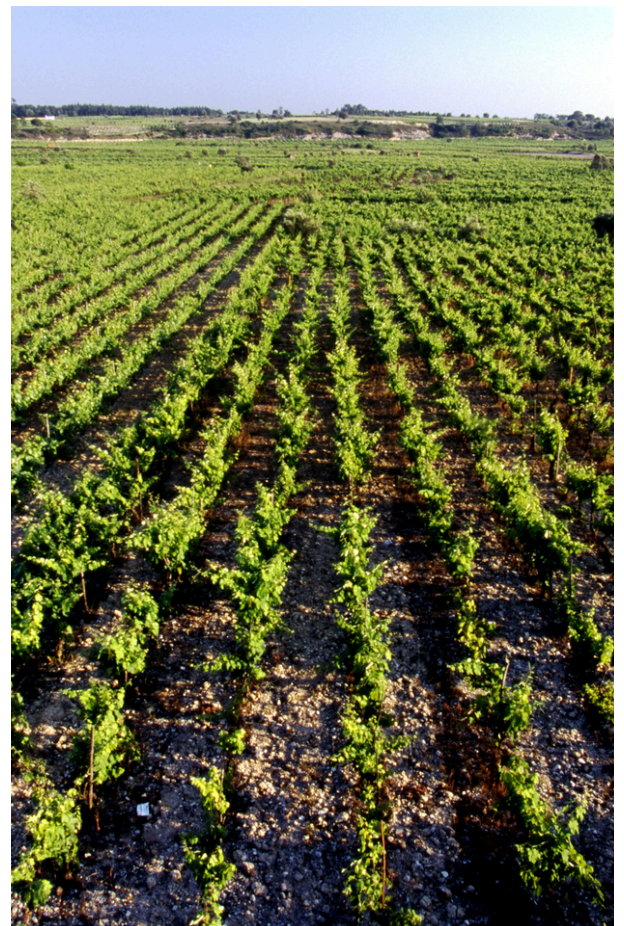

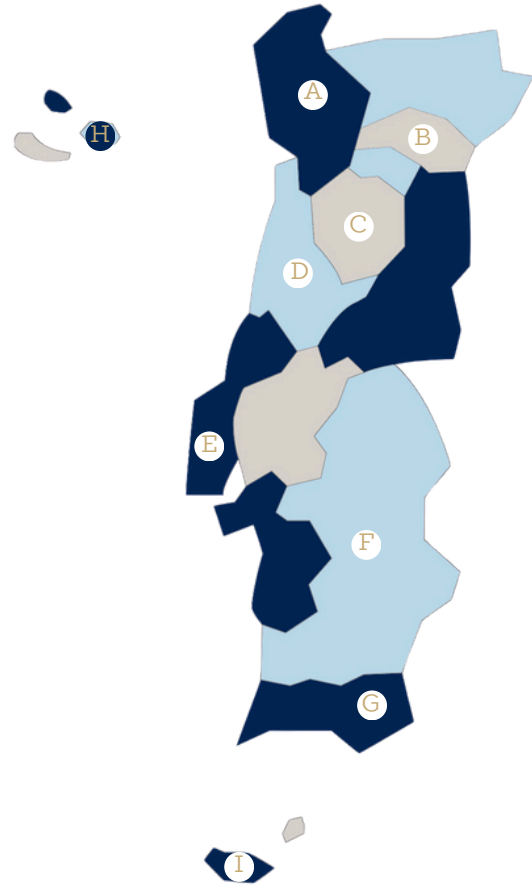


## ► MADEIRA
