Cascais is a delighful Portuguese fishing town and is the Lisbon's coastline most popular holiday destination. The town is situated on a beautiful coastline, and during the summer it is bustling with a holiday atmosphere. Cascais also makes for an enjoyable day trip from Lisbon, by offering historic buildings, interesting museums and a pretty town center. As for beaches, there are two distinct coastlines; to the east are calm, family friendly beaches; while to the north are the wild and regged surfing beaches of the Serra Sintra.





Cascais is the finest resort town of the Lisbon region. Estoril is a stylish and fashionable Portuguese beach resort that is situated on the beautiful coastline that extends to the west of Lisbon. Estoril strikes the perfect balance between Portugueses charm and excellent tourist facilities. It is an ideal destination for people who want more than just great beachs for their holiday.

Within the Estoril region, there is a diverse selection of sights and activities; these include glorious beaches, championship grade golf courses and historic towns to explore. From Estoril it is only a short walk to the picturesque fishing town of Cascais, while to the north are the scenic hills of the Serra de Sintra and the pretty town of Sintra.



We travel to the heart of the Douro, between Régua and Pinhão.

The emblematic Quinta that we are going to visit is strategically located at the confluence of the Douro and Tejo rivers. We start by visiting the vineyards and the Pombaline Landmarks that are in this property and that served to delimit the 1st Demarcated and Regulated Zone of the World. Back to Quinta we can visit the vineyards, the winery and taste some exclusive and award winning wines, which make this small producer one of the best in the Region.







The wines are accompanied by other products typical of the Douro, such as bread, cheese, olive oil and sausages. During the visit, we will discuss the measures that this Quinta is promoting to reduce its environmental impact and also how we can learn and incorporate some of these measures into our daily lives. We suggest ending the experience with a lunch with Chef Thomas Egger. Thomas Egger is an Austrian chef who has been based in Tabuaço for 15 years and is the only Green Chef in Portugal, demonstrating his environmental concern in the confection of traditional Douro dishes. He also developed his own line of products, namely olive oil, olives and wine. After lunch, we head to the waterfront once again. This time we will visit the village of Pinão and its beautifully decorated train station. Walking in the Pinhão quay we will see the place where the barrels were loaded onto the Rabelo boats and the changes that occurred when the dams were built.

Lastly we will hear to Casal de Loivos for our last wine tasting and enjoy the scenery ate the historical viewpoint.

Porto Tour

Porto is the second-largest city in Portugal: after Lisbon. It is one of the major urban areas of the Iberian Peninsula.

The city proper has a population of 237,591 and the metropolitan area of Porto, makes it the second-largest urban area in Portugal. Located along the Douro river estuary in Northern Portugal, Porto is one of the oldest European centers. The historical center was proclaimed a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1996.

The western part of its urban area extends to the coastline of the Atlantic Ocean. Porto settlement dates back many centuries when it was an outpost of the Roman Empire.

The combined Celtic–Latin name, Portus Cale, has been referred to as the origin of the name "Portugal" Such distinction Is based on transliteration and oral evolution from Latin

In Portuguese, the name of the city is spelled with a definite article o Porto. The English name evolved from a misinterpretation of the oral pronunciation and referred to as Oporto in modern literature and by many speakers. One of Portugal's internationally famous exports, port wine, is named after Porto.

The metropolitan area, and in particular, the cellars of Vila Nova de Gaia, were responsible for the packaging, transport, and export of the fortified wine.

In 2014 and 2017, Porto was elected The Best European Destination by the Best European Destinations Agency. Porto is on the Portuguese Way path of the Caminho de Santiago.

Many wonders await us in our Porto tour: from monuments and buildings like the Sé Catedral or Torre dos Clérigos, parks such as Passeio das Virtudes and Parque da Cidade, the old city by the river (Cais da Ribeira) or the shoreline and its beaches.

Porto has something new to discover around every corner!

The best of what the Douro has to offer, in a new, top of the line, deluxe program with only private visits! Our day starts in the Porto with an early pick-up. Our first stop is the Douro Museum, where you will learn about the history, the wines and the tradicions of a Douro Valley with a private guided tour.

To open your appetite, a glass of Port wine will be served at the end of the visit. Afterward, we will head to a Vineyard – we call them "Quintas" – that has the most beautiful views over the surrounding terraces – our "socalcos" where grapevines grow and mountain rages in the distance. Very small producer, with top of the line wines.





Putting the knowledge you previously acquired, you will see where the grapes are grown, the lagar where they are foottreaded and the barrels where the wine rests and ages. Of course, a tasting is mandatory and you will find a small producer with quality surpassing big houses. After the visit, the lunch break follows, in a Restaurant with the best view over the river. After lunch, we descend to the water's edge to enjoy a small electric boat cruise, the only one in the country. From the dock of Pinhão, we can see the vineyards and farms located upstream, in a route that is not otherwise accessible. Still in Pinhão you will have the opportunity to visit the most beautiful railway station in Portugal, with sixteen panels of tiles, alluding to the processes related to wine, typical of the Douro culture. To finish the day, and since the Douro is not just wine, we will also know an old olive oil mill. transformed into a museum, belonging to the same family for four generations. Here we can taste different but equally typical products of the region: olive oil, honey, and almonds, as well as a small sample of wines - in a breathtaking landscape. During the return to Porto, you will have the opportunity to rest to the music of your choice.

Evora Tour

Évora is a UNESCO world cultural heritage since 1986. Throughout our tour, we will visit some of the most important sites of the city and region.

Évora and its surrounding region have a rich history that retreats more than five millennia. Archaeological excavations, however, have not shown up to now whether the area of the present town was inhabited before the arrival of the Romans.

This charming tour starts in Lisbon, where you begin traveling to the southern part of the country, Alentejo.

The visit begins with the beautiful medieval city of Évora, the historical center in Alto Alentejo. Its most important monuments are The Cathedral, Roman Temple, Church of St. Francisco and its bones chapel. Then we drive to see the amazing local vineyards. After that, we can enjoy lunch in a friendly local atmosphere known for its excellent cuisine and for offering the world's finest wines.

Before return, you may visit the cork factory and store.



Douro Flowering Almond Trees

Bit by bit, it will be unraveled the Legend of the Flowering Almond Trees.

Once we arrive at Foz Côa, lunch break follows with a magnificent view, alongside its delicious and refined food and wine tasting. After lunch, we continue our journey to Freixo de Espada à Cinta, on the border of Spain. Here we can visit the Castle and be amazed by its singular view over the Douro and beyond. Starting our way back to Porto, see the contrast of the scenery on the North of the River, the final section of the Flowering Almond Tree Route. Once more, due to the extension of the course, we will need to stop at the quick charger in Vila Real.

Listen to some music of your choice and relax on the way back.


Douro Harvest

Septembre is that month marking the Harvest. It is a time of great work and a unique opportunity to foot tread the grapes and make your own wine! This Experience begins in Régua where we will meet our first host: Douro Museum. This learning center will show us all about the region, its history, the processes related to wine culture. The transport of the barrels, the historical characters, associated histories and legends are other highlights of this first stop.

The lunch break, which will include a wine tasting, will be held at the Museum's Restaurant.

Alternatively, you may choose a wine-paired lunch at the Quinta we will be visiting during the afternoon.





Now that we have acquired some knowledge, we can put it to practice. We head on to the Quinta to join in a harvest and lagarada – foot treading. Stomping the grapes is a unique experience, resulting from a secular tradition. Winemakers believe there is no substitute that can grant the wines their unique and distinctive characteristics. In the end, we will have a traditional snack with wine tasting, courtesy of the Quinta. Starting our journey back to Porto, take this time to relax and enjoy the quietness of the ride and the beauty of Douro Valley landscape.



Douro Olives and Olive Oil


Originally used to mark the boundaries of the vineyard from each producer, the olives trees were also an additional source of income. This way viticulturists weren't solely relying on their grapes and wine production. Olive oil was considered a deluxe product. out of reach from the majority of the people. The Douro landscape does not allow for mechanized harvest, so we still use the traditional harvesting method.

Their quality is unsurpassed by other olive oils! Of course, we will also have the chance to taste some great Port and table wines along the way!

- * The terms contained in the Particular Conditions, if any, shall prevail over the provisions of these General Conditions, both of which shall prevail over any additional written provisions specially agreed between the Client and the AGENCY.
- * The services and products are offered to Customer under the terms and conditions expressed herein.
- * By contracting with the AGENCY the Client acknowledges and accepts all the terms and conditions established.

Registrations

* At the time of registration, the traveler will make the payment requested. If the registration takes place 21 days or less from the date of commencement of service, the total price of the service must be paid at the time of registration. The AGENCY reserves the right to cancel any subscription whose payment has not been made under the conditions mentioned above. The reservations are conditional upon obtaining the part of the suppliers of the confirmation of all the services

Information pursuant to law no. 144/2015 of September 8

* Under the terms of Law no. 144/2015 of September 8, in its current version, we inform that the Traveler may use the following Alternative Dispute Resolution Entities:

Arbitration Commission of Tourism of Portugal www.turismodeportugal.pt

Claims

- * Any disagreement in the execution of a travel service included in the package travel contract must be communicated to the travel agent in writing or other appropriate form as soon as such discontinuance occurs, ie without undue delay.
- * The right to present claims for the purpose of price reduction or compensation for lack of conformity of the travel services included in the package travels within a period of two years

Baggage

* The agency is responsible for baggage under legal terms; The Traveler has an obligation to complain to the entity providing the services at the moment of subtraction, deterioration or destruction of luggage. In the international transport, in case of damage in the luggage, the complaint must be made in writing to the carrier immediately after the verification of the damage and a maximum of 7 days from its delivery. In case of a delay in the delivery of the luggage, the claim must be made within 21 days from the date of delivery. The presentation of such a complaint will be an essential basis for triggering the responsibility of the AGENCY over the entity providing the service.

Limits

Hotels / Apartments

* Apartments - In case the accommodation is hired in an apartment it is the responsibility of the Traveler to inform the number of people who will occupy the apartment. If there are more people than booked, the apartments may refuse entry.

Hotels - The price shown is per person and are based on a double occupancy. Not all hotels have a triple room and, as a rule, there is an extra bed that may not be of the same quality. In rooms equipped with two beds or double, the triple can only consist of those beds. The list of hotels and apartments contained in the programs is indicative as well as their category which meets local criteria and classifications whose criteria are sometimes different from those used in Portugal.

Meals

* Unless otherwise noted, prices shown for half board and full board supplements do not include beverages. On arrival at the hotel after 7pm the first meal service will be breakfast the next day, on the last day and unless there is a possibility of late check-out, the last service of the hotel will be breakfast.

Schedule of entry and exit

* The hours and entrance and exit on the first and last day will be defined according to the first and last service. As a rule, non-binding rooms can be used from 2 pm on the day of arrival and must be left free until 12 noon on the day of departure. In the apartments

the check-in usually takes place at 5 pm on the day of arrival and must be left free until 10 am on the day of departure.

Special Conditions for Children

* Given the diversity of conditions applied to children (destination and supplier) it is recommended to always question the special conditions that may be applied to the trip in question.

General Conditions Mototourism Reservations and deposits

- * You will be required to pay only 50% of the total value, which secures a space on the tour. Space is limited and reservations are on a first come basis. The balance is due only 10 days prior to day zero.
- * If it is the case you prefer to rent a bike, the rental period is not interrupted due to a riding inability of a renter or for any other reason.
- * During the tour MTLV Viagens is not obliged to replace a damaged motorcycle, but we will help you to rent one.

Own motorcycle

* When a customer brings his/her own motorcycle for use on a tour no insurance is provided by Destiny-Portugal.

Cancellation and refunds

* Cancellations received more than 60 days prior to departure will be subject to a 300 Euro per person cancellation fee. Cancellations received less than 60 days prior to departure will not be refundable. Trip Cancellation Insurance is strongly recommended.

Minimum tour participation

* Up to four weeks prior to the tour start, MTLV Viagens Lda can cancel the tour if a sufficient number of customers for the particular tour is not reached. In this case the customer will be notified forthwith and his payment refunded in full, which constitutes the full settlement.

Tour cancellation
